

#### **INSTRUCTIONS FOR ADMISSIONS**

#### SECTION A (Criteria for admissions)

#### 1. Admission criteria for Std X:

- <u>Holy Cross High School</u>: Students securing 45% and above either in the Terminal Examination or I /II Unit test in Std. IX or 45% marks in the Final Examination of Std. VIII can take direct admission on producing their original mark sheet.
- <u>Karthika High School / Michael High School/ any other English Medium school:</u> Students securing 45% and above either in the Terminal Examination (Std. IX) or I /II Unit Test (Std. IX) or 45% marks in the Final Examination of Std. VIII can take direct admission on producing their original mark sheet or Xerox copy of the same, subject to verification.
- Classes for Std. X shall commence from 17<sup>th</sup> April, 2024. Timings and subjects will be put on the website and classes notice board on 16<sup>th</sup> April, 2024.

#### 2. Admission criteria for Standard V - IX:

#### <u>a) Std IX</u>:

- <u>Holy Cross</u>: Students securing 45% and above either in the Final Examination (Std VII) or I Unit Test (Std VIII) or I Terminal Examination (Std VIII) can take direct admission on producing their original mark sheet or Xerox copy of the same, subject to verification.
- <u>Karthika High School and Michael High School</u>: Students securing 45% and above either in the Final Examination (Std VII) or I Unit Test (Std VIII) or I Terminal Examination (Std VIII) can take direct admission on producing their original mark sheet or Xerox copy of the same, subject to verification.
- There are no batches for any other school apart from the above three schools.
- Classes for Std IX shall commence from 4<sup>th</sup> June, 2024. Timings will be displayed one day prior to the commencement of the classes.

#### b) Std VIII: (ONLY FOR STUDENTS OF HOLY CROSS & MICHAEL HIGH SCHOOL)

- Students can take direct admission on producing their original mark sheet of the Final Examination (Std VI) or I Unit Test (Std VII) or I Terminal Examination (Std VII).
- Classes for Std VIII shall commence from 4<sup>th</sup> June, 2024. Timings will be displayed one day prior to the commencement of the classes.

#### d) Std VII: (ONLY FOR STUDENTS OF HOLY CROSS)

- Students can take direct admission on producing their original mark sheet of the Final Examination (Std V) or I Unit Test (Std VI) or I Terminal Examination (Std VI).
- Classes for Std VII shall commence from 4<sup>th</sup> June, 2024. Timings will be displayed one day prior to the commencement of the classes.

#### e) Std VI: (ONLY FOR STUDENTS OF HOLY CROSS)

- Students can take direct admission on producing their original mark sheet of the Final Examination (Std IV) or I Unit Test (Std V) or I Terminal Examination (Std V).
- Classes for Std VI shall commence from 13<sup>th</sup> June, 2024. Timings will be displayed one day prior to the commencement of the classes.

#### f) Std.V: (ONLY FOR STUDENTS OF HOLY CROSS)

- Students can secure admissions directly on producing their School mark sheet.
- Classes for Std V shall commence from 13<sup>th</sup> June, 2024. Timings will be displayed one day prior to the commencement of the classes.

#### 2. Information pertaining to work schedules of Std. X:

i) The management and the staff aim at coaching the students keeping in mind the Board Exams of Std. X. Therefore, much importance will not be given to the completion of portion for the Unit tests or Terminal Examinations but necessary guidance will be given

to the students. The entire portion will be completed before the onset of the Preliminary Examinations.

- ii) Students of Std X can opt for one of the two batches as given below.
- Choice of batch for Std X is on first come first served basis. No request for a particular batch will be considered once the seats are filled. Also, no request to change the batch will be considered once a particular batch is selected.

**<u>N.B</u>**: 1) All the above timings are subject to change in case of unavoidable circumstances

- Also note that there will be no lectures from the 22<sup>nd</sup> Dec, 2024 to 1<sup>st</sup> Jan, 2025. However, Preliminary exams will be held during the Christmas vacation. Thereafter, there will be revision classes from 2<sup>nd</sup> January 2025 onwards for the SSC students till the beginning of the S.S.C Exams.
- 3) The students of Std X will be reshuffled into batches in the month of November 2024 on the basis of their performance in the tests held in the classes throughout the year. No request for change of batch will be entertained at that stage.
- The Office and the classes will remain closed from 23<sup>rd</sup> May 2024 to 2<sup>nd</sup> June 2024 (both days inclusive)

#### SECTION D (General Instruction for Admission)

- 1) Admissions for Std X will commence from the **11**<sup>th</sup> **December**, **2023**.
- 2) Admissions for Std V IX will commence from the 4<sup>th</sup> January, 2024.
- 3) Admission related procedure will be taken up on all working days during office hours only. No admission related work will be taken up on Sundays and public holidays.
- 4) Fees will be accepted from Monday to Saturday between 9.00 am to 11.30 am and 2.30 pm to 7.00 pm only.

- 5) It is our endeavour to hold <u>OFFLINE</u> (physical) lectures for the academic year 2024-2025. However, in case of an emergency situation such as lockdown imposed by the Government due to any reason whatsoever, the lectures will be held <u>ONLINE</u>. Under such circumstances the fees paid will not be refunded.
- 6) Fees have to be paid in time. Failure to pay the fees by the due date will result in cancellation of admission. <u>FEES PAID FOR THE ACADEMIC YEAR 2024-2025 WILL</u> <u>NOT BE REFUNDED</u>, except if the student fails in the previous standard. Also original mark sheet indicating that the student has failed has to be shown and a Xerox copy of the same has to be submitted. Also please note that in such cases, only tuition fees will be refunded. GST collected will not be refunded under any circumstances.
- 7) <u>No donations are accepted for admissions.</u>
- 8) The decision of the management, as far as admissions are concerned, will be final. No recommendations will be considered.
- 9) The institution requires a high degree of discipline. Students are therefore requested to strictly abide by all the rules and regulations.
